RESOLUTIONS FORM: February 3, 2026 Precinct Caucuses

Steps to change the platform of the Republican Party of Minnesota:

1. Resolutions that are passed at the **Precinct Caucus** will be forwarded to the **2026 BPOU Convention**.
2. The **BPOU Convention** votes on these Resolutions, requiring a simple majority to pass.
3. Resolutions that are passed at the **BPOU Convention** are then to be forwarded to the **2026 Congressional District Convention** where they are voted on; a simple majority is required to pass.
4. Resolutions that are passed at the **Congressional District Convention** will then be forwarded to the **2026 State Convention** where they are voted on; where once again a simple majority is required to pass.
5. Resolutions that are passed at the 2026 State Convention are incorporated into the **Standing Platform** of the **Republican Party of Minnesota**.

The Standing Platform of the Republican Party of Minnesota has **10 PLANKS**. Before writing your proposed Resolution, indicate to which PLANK your Resolution pertains (review the accompanying **Standing Platform** for current wording of the standing planks). If you feel your resolution does not fit in a specific plank, check "OTHER":

As soon as you have your resolution written, give it to the caucus secretary. A maximum 5 minute discussion, pro and con alternately, will follow. A vote will take place and if passed, this resolution will be forwarded to the BPOU Convention.

I move that this precinct caucus support the following change to the above plank (1 of the 11 must be checked): (you may attach an additional sheet if more space is needed)

The following is a consolidation of all the Resolutions passed at Cass County caucuses

1. Reinstate our "old" Minnesota flag.
2. Support the SAVE act which mandates in-person voting and documentary proof of US citizenship for voter registration.
3. Ensure that educational funds follow the student to whatever school they choose that is a Christian or Charter school.
4. Change the language from "strengthening" the rule of law to "enforcing" the rule of law.
5. Update school choice language to Section 4 of the Educate Our Children plank as follows to include Education Savings Accounts (ESAs):
"Expanding tax credits, deductions, and ~~voucher programs~~ Education Savings Accounts (ESAs), including for students attending religious schools."
6. Restore state support for pregnancy resource centers.
In Section 2 (on civil rights) of the existing Republican Party of Minnesota Platform, under the subsection "Defend the Right to Life,"
"Resolved, that the state of Minnesota should reinstate the Positive Alternatives Act, which gave women in need and their unborn children lifesaving access to assistance and alternatives to abortion through a state grant program for pro-life pregnancy resource centers."

7. Eliminate “comparable sales” in computing property taxes.

8. Abolish the IRS & Federal Reserve

9. Re-establish state mental institutions to take care of our mentally disabled citizens – remove them from jails, prisons, and the streets.

10. Change the Minnesota Human Rights Act to protect the rights of a pharmacist that declines to dispense the morning after pill based upon his/her conscience and that it not be deemed discriminatory.

11. The State of Minnesota abolish all laws concerning the annexation of Land, Townships, or unorganized by cities.

12. Support the “Never Again Bill” HF2204 (2022)/HF4257 (2024) which repeals the Govenor’s ability to declare an emergency.
