#### REPUBLICAN PARTY OF MINNESOTA SENATE DISTRICT 33 BYLAWS

# **Article I. Purpose**

The Senate District is to find, support and develop Republican candidates and get them elected to all levels of government, including but not limited to:

- 1. Federal Officials
- 2. State Officials
- 3. Municipal Officials
- 4. County Officials
- 5. Local Boards
- 6. School Boards
- 7. Local committees and government advisory panels.

We shall seek out and support candidates with our ideals and values. We shall endorse and support them with our actions and ideas. We shall hold our elected leaders accountable, make sure they are following conservative ideals and values, and ensure we have a representative government.

### Article II. Candidate Consideration

**Section 1 Endorsements:** All endorsements must be done by vote at an endorsement convention by voting delegates and seated alternates.

**Section 2 Preferred Candidates:** County, Municipal, School Board and other offices of any political subdivision at least partly within our Senate District boundaries. Preferment can made by the Executive or Full Committee.

**Section 3 Once Endorsed/Preferred:** A candidate is then, and only then, eligible to receive party voter lists pertaining to his/her district. Lists will be shared upon receiving a signed list sharing agreement.

# **Article III. Expenditures**

**Section 1 All Expenditures:** Must be authorized by the Executive or Full Committee with a simple majority vote, prior to any payment.

**Section 2 In the Event of an Emergency:** The Presiding Officer of SD33, the Treasurer, and one other officer may authorize payment up to \$250.00 without either committee approving the expense, provided all parties agree prior to payment being made. The Expense will be reported at the next meeting with an explanation as to why it was an emergency.
